Question 1 Does CCBO have grant opportunities in other cities? How about the city of Salatiga?

Answer 1 For Central Java, CCBO will be working only in Semarang only. Outside Central Java, CCBO will work in Makassar and Ambon. Organizations interested in working in other cities are encouraged to regularly check the Urban Links website to learn where CCBO is working and available grant opportunities.

Question 2 Are the documents needed for the media embargo mandatory?

Answer 2 Yes. As a USAID implementing partner, CCBO works closely with the Agency to officially announce its grant agreements. Until grant agreements are officially signed and counter-signed and explicit permission is granted to the awarded grant organization, CCBO prohibits organizations from sharing or publishing announcements of their award. All announcements are strictly embargoed until grant agreements and signed, countersigned, and the grantee has received permission from CCBO.

By agreeing to the media embargo rules, the applicant's representative is committing to the terms of the embargo not only on their behalf but that of the organization.

Question 3 How much is the total grant?

Answer 3 CCBO anticipates awarding (1) one technical assistance grant to not exceed \$320,0000 to achieve the activities described in the Request for Application over a period of 24 months.
